

Mineral and raw resources are presented by reserves of oil shale, brown coal, building stone, kaoline, peat and potassium salt.

Water resources

Main rivers are the River Pripyat and its tributaries the Sluch, the Stviga, the Skripitsa, the Nauts, the Svinovod.

Big lakes are Lake Beloye, Lake Chervonoye.

Forestry and environmental resources

Forests cover 55,7% of the territory.

Tourism potential

Tourist traffic is **more than 100 thousand** people a year.

The historical centre is the **town of Turov**.

Turov is included into a system of tourist routes “The Golden Ring Of Turovshchina” and is famous for a monument to a church leader and writer of Ancient Rus Kirill of Turov, Zamkovaya Hora (an ancient hill where the old town was situated), the local museum and the Museum of Belarusian Natural History.

Turov Church of All Saints, The Saint Boris and Gleb chapel and the cemetery with its miracle-working crosses, a monument to 100 anniversary of the Turov diocese, the Cathedral of Kirill and Lavrenty of Turov, a monument to Duke Konstantin Ostrozhsy who was born here are situated in Turov.



Business support infrastructure
